- Family friendly rooms available in the Great Room and Women's Restroom with live video feed and activities for the kids.

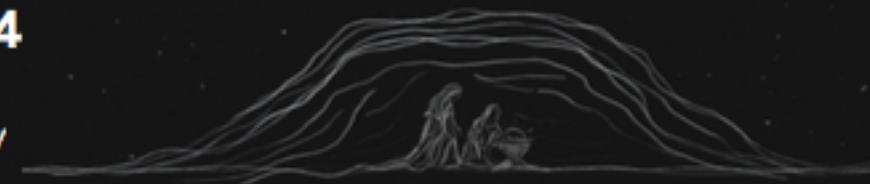
